


# **Notice to Mariners**

### **Vessels and General Safety Advice**

Deployment of scientific equipment 12/06/2019

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

Mariners are advised that The Scottish Salmon Company (SSC) will be carrying out a Hydrographic survey in June in Loch Roag. The survey equipment deployment is planned to start on 12/06/2019 and will last approximately **110 days'**, weather depending. The approximate deployment area, shown by the yellow marker, is illustrated on the chart extract below:



#### 2. SAFETY

Throughout operations, the vessel will be displaying the shapes and lights prescribed in the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) Rule 27 and will be displaying the prescribed shapes and lights when the vessel is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre. Furthermore, it is requested that anybody having knowledge of any potential objects submerged or moored on the seabed, within the survey areas, that could be damaged or form a hazard to the vessel and its equipment advises SSC of their position and nature. When operations commence a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 12 and 16 when within the appropriate port authority area.
