Mariners are advised that from 05th November 2025 to 30th November 2025 the Fugro jack up barge (JUB) "Aran 250" will be performing nearshore geotechnical boreholes. These works will be conducted on behalf of Scottish & Southern Electricity Networks Transmission (SSENT).

The Aran 250 will be positioned for borehole sampling at Arnish Point and at Dundonnell within Little Loch Broom.

A 200m exclusion zone will be enforced around the JUB at all times. Vessels are to take caution when navigating in this area and pass well clear of the JUB.

Programmed works will commence at Arnish from 08th November 2025.


Geotechnical operations at the site are expected to be carried out from the Jack Up Barge (JUB), Aran 250 and will be operational 24hrs a day, unless stood down by weather conditions.

- Day Shift 0700hrs to 1900hrs
- Night Shift 1900hrs to 0700hrs


JUB crew will not be living on board and the Vigilant RHIB will be operational between Stornoway for the Arnish Point scope, and Ullapool for the Dundonnell scope. Crew transfers will occur twice daily.

The JUB will be supported by a dedicated multicat Leanne P and C-Force.

The Aran 250 will be towed using the Leanne P from Kishorn to Stornoway, and then from Stornoway to Arnish. Once the Arnish works are complete, it will then be towed again from Stornoway to Dundonnell.

Exclusion Zones

When Aran 250 is jacked to safe working height it requires a 200m exclusion zone for all other marine traffic wherever possible. Should it be necessary for a vessel to make a planned entry into the exclusion zone, vessels are requested to contact the Barge Master.

When Aran 250 is in the water or under tow, it requires a 200m exclusion zone wherever possible and a speed reduction for all vessels who wish to pass it to minimise wake and wash.

The jack-up barge will be lit to and display RED_WHITE_RED lighting and shapes to indicate that it is a vessel restricted in its ability to maneuver.

Expected crew transfer Distance: 2.5Nm (Arnish to Stornoway) 18Nm (Dundonnell to Ullapool)

Transfer Duration: 15 minutes (Arnish) 30 Minutes (Dundonnell)

A continuous listening watch will be conducted on VHF Channel 14.
