



CANNA HARBOUR NOTICE TO MARINERS no: 7/25

Anchoring within Canna Harbour

Due to several instances of vessels dragging their anchors, Mariners are advised to take extreme caution when attempting to anchor within the harbour, particularly in moderate to strong N-NE winds.

In such conditions, Mariners are strongly advised to maintain a good anchor watch at all times.

The bottom of the harbour has a large amount of weed, and this can prevent anchors catching should they lose their holding. The cleanest area is between the two chapels.

Any vessel that does run aground should contact HM Coastguard on 999/VHF channel 16 in the first instance.

In addition, mariners are also advised that Notice to Mariners number 2, regarding the reef adjacent to the slipway, as well as Notice to Mariners number 6, regarding the harbour works, are both hereby cancelled and are no longer in effect.
